(1), and Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care... (1). On Playground 2, a vertical slat on the wooden barrier behind the shed was broken, creating sharp edges. On the south side of the complex climber, the gray paint was chipping. Violation confirmed corrected by lette

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

An Albuterol inhaler was stored in a child's backpack in a cubby and was not stored out of reach of children. Violation corrected during visit
