Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet. (1), and A First Aid Information Sheet Was Not Posted in a Place for Referral And/or the Information Sheet Did Not Include All the Required Information. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child sized blue chair was cracked creating opening for children's hands to become stuck in Space #1. Violation corrected during visit

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. Three sections of the fence located at the rear of the outdoor play area were measured and found to be between 3ft. 9 in. and 3ft. 10in

● **A First Aid Information Sheet Was Not Posted in a Place for Referral And/or the Information Sheet Did Not Include All the Required Information.**

A First Aid information sheet was not posted in the facility. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/17/2026
