(1), and Refrigerator Was Not Maintained at a Temperature of 45 Degrees Fahrenheit or Below And/or Was Not Monitored by a Refrigerator Thermometer. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The operator did not offer alternative activities for children under the age of three years. The tv was playing children's programming while an infant and toddler were present. Violation corrected during visit

The refrigerator did not contain a thermometer. Violation corrected during visit
