Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were All Medicines, Including Refrigerated and Unrefrigerated, Were Not Kept in Locked Storage. (2), Written Record of Up-to-date Pet Vaccinations as Required by NC Law and Local Ordinances, Including Rabies Vaccination for Dogs and Cats, Was Not Available. (1), and Prescribed Medications Were Not Stored in Their Original Containers in Which They Are Dispensed with the Pharmacy Label. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Jul 24, 2023 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **All Medicines, Including Refrigerated and Unrefrigerated, Were Not Kept in Locked Storage.**

Bottles of Tylenol, prescription cream and cough medicine was stored in an unlocked container on top of the refrigerator. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/28/2

● **Written Record of Up-to-date Pet Vaccinations as Required by NC Law and Local Ordinances, Including Rabies Vaccination for Dogs and Cats, Was Not Available.**

The written record of up-to-date vaccination on file for one pet expired on July 6, 2023. Violation confirmed corrected by letter

● **Prescribed Medications Were Not Stored in Their Original Containers in Which They Are Dispensed with the Pharmacy Label.**

A tube of Triamcinolone on site for one child was not store in its original container. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/28/2023
