(1), and The Medical Action Plan Was Not Updated on an Annual Basis or When Changes to the Plan Were Made by the Child's Parent or Health Care Professional. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space #F4, a bottle of sunscreen was stored in a cubby that was not at least five feet from the floor as required. Violation corrected during visit
