(1), and Products That Are Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Without Any Other Warnings, Were Not Stored on a Shelf or in an Unlocked Cabinet That Is Five Feet... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A fire drill was not conducted in June 2024. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/16/2024

Jul 20, 2023 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **The Operator Did Not Conduct a Monthly Fire Drill.**

A June 2023 fire drill was not documented on the Emergency Drill Log & Report for Family Child Care Homes. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/20/2023

- **Products That Are Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Without Any Other Warnings, Were Not Stored on a Shelf or in an Unlocked Cabinet That Is Five Feet...**

above the finished floor. Two (2) bottles of Sure Original Scent Solid Deodorant were stored in an unlocked drawer in the bathro

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- **Jump Ropes and Rubber Bands Were Accessible to Children Under Five Years of Age, Without Adult Supervision.**

A bag of rubber bands was stored in an unlocked drawer in the kitchen. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/20/2023

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
