Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date. (1), Each Child's Diapers Were Not Changed at Areas Designated Exclusively for Diapering, on a Surface That Was Smooth, Nonabsorbent, Easily Cleanable and of Tight... (1), and Formula and Other Beverages Which Require Refrigeration Were Not Identified for Each Child or Properly Refrigerated. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date.**

In space #2 a child had diaper ointment that had expired 1/2024. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/8/2025

● **Each Child's Diapers Were Not Changed at Areas Designated Exclusively for Diapering, on a Surface That Was Smooth, Nonabsorbent, Easily Cleanable and of Tight...**

● **Formula and Other Beverages Which Require Refrigeration Were Not Identified for Each Child or Properly Refrigerated.**

In space #1 two children did not have their name and date on their bottles. Violation corrected during visit

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

The playhouse on the younger playground had nails protruding out and broken wood that could cause splinters. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/8/2025
