Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards. (1), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and Emergency and Identifying Information, Including the Child's Name, Photograph, Emergency Contact Information And/or a Copy of the Emergency Medical Care... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards.**

In space 6b, the face of the desk drawer was missing and the counter tip of the dramatic play kitchen set was detached and exposed two screws. Violation corrected during visit

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A moldy towel and a ride on triceratops toy was stored in the bin on outdoor space #1. Violation corrected during visit

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

On August 4, 2025, staff in space #4 was observed leaving the classroom and going into an adjacent classroom (space #5), leaving eight children unattended. On August 7, 2025, a staff in space #1 was observed looking down at their p

About this report

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● **Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older.**

Thirty (30) children ranging in age from one to three years of age were grouped together on playground space #2 together. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/1

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
