Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1), The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of. (1), and Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
