The orientation for two staff members who had been employed more than six weeks had not been completed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/2/2

● **At Least One Child Care Provider, Who Has Completed ITS-SIDS Training Was Not Present in the Infant Room, While Children Were in Care.**

The only staff member providing care in the space where infants received care had not completed ITS-SIDS training. Violation confirmed corrected by I

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
