(1), Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible. (1), and All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
