Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Outdoor Play Area Did Not Provide an Area That Is Shaded. (1), Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1), and Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Outdoor Play Area Did Not Provide an Area That Is Shaded.**

The tarp covering of the stationary shade structure was missing and no alternative shade was offered. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/2/2025

Sep 5, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection.**

Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. A previous fire inspection was dated 8/2/23.

● **Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards.**

Mildew was observed on the stationary climbing structure in the outdoor play space. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/19/2024

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Mulch is growing in the mulch of the containment area near the climbing structure and the easel. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/19/2024
