(2), Medical Exam or Health Assessment Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission. (1), and The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Tops on storage container were cracked exposing sharp edges, and a red child-sized chair was cracked in the seat in Space #7. Violation corrected during visit

● **Medical Exam or Health Assessment Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission.**

The medical assessment for one child enrolled on January 20, 2024, was dated for April 10, 2024. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/8/2025

● **The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current.**

The center's EPR plan was not reviewed annually by trained staff. The last review date documented was February 2024. Violation corrected during visit
