(1), Diapers Were Not Changed Whenever They Were Soiled or Wet And/or Were Changed on a Shift Basis. (1), and A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

● **Diapers Were Not Changed Whenever They Were Soiled or Wet And/or Were Changed on a Shift Basis.**

A child in space #6 had a soiled diaper that did not get change on a as needed basis. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/17/2025

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

During the center's lockdown two classrooms did not go into their assigned designated areas to secure the children from any potential danger that could have occurred. Violation confirmed corrected by letter recei
