Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Surfacing Did Not Extend Six (6) Feet Beyond the External Limits of the Equipment or 3 Feet for Equipment Used Only by Children Less Than 2 Years of Age. (1), Safe Pick-up and Delivery Procedures Were Not Communicated to Parents And/or Were Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen by the Parents. (1), and Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. The fence in the lower corner measured 3 feet 11 inches instead of 4 feet high. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from p
