● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

The blue chairs in space #8 contained chipping blue paint and the blue vinyl child-sized chair in the library area, in space #8 contained torn vinyl, exposing foam. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In space #345, the outlet beside the bathroom c

● **A Burn Hazard in the Kitchen Was Accessible to Children.**

The kitchen located next to space #345 was accessible to the school-aged children in space #345, as the door to the kitchen (where the water used for cleaning and sanitizing utensils is above 120 degrees Fahrenheit) was observed
