Shade was not available in any area of the outdoor space. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/31/2025
- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**
In the classroom, the bottom of the cabinet under the sink is damp and appears to have black mold. The handle on the front door has been broken and is missing. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received fro
- **The Child Care Center Premises, Including the Outdoor Learning Environment, Was Not Clean, Drained to Minimize Standing Water, Free of Litter and Hazards,...**
and/or maintained in a manner which does not create conditions that attract or harbor pests. Today the grass was over 6 inches hig
