(2), A Violation Was Found for Which There Is No Item Number. (1), and The Written Feeding Plan Was Not Modified as the Child's Needs Changed. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **The Written Feeding Plan Was Not Modified as the Child's Needs Changed.**
The feeding plan for a child 13 months of age enrolled in classroom space #5 did not indicate the child having table foods. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/20/2025
- **The Child Care Center Premises, Including the Outdoor Learning Environment, Was Not Clean, Drained to Minimize Standing Water, Free of Litter and Hazards,...**
