● **Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards.**

The stationary equipment had rust exposed on platforms, steps and sides of the equipment where the rubber had worn away. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/9/2025

● **Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible.**

One (1) picnic table on the side play area had warped and splintering boards accessible to children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received f

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**

● **Emergency Information Record Did Not Include Chronic Illness and Any Medication Taken for the Illness.**

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

The mulch under the stationary play equipment was compacted and measured 4.25" at the deepest depth. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/30/2025

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
