Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1), Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), and Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

Two classrooms did not have current activity plans posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/12/2026

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

Diapers in a plastic bag was observed being stored in an unlocked cabinet underneath a changing table. Violation confirmed corrected by let

● **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

Three infants ages 0-12 months were observed sleeping in cribs on their tummies but there was no documentation indicating that they can roll. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/12/2026

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

The mulch on the large outdoor playground measured 1/2" which does not meet the required level of surfacing. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/13/2026

● **The EMC Plan Was Not Reviewed with All Staff Annually and Whenever the Plan Was Revised.**

One staff member did not have documentation on file that the center EMC plan was reviewed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/10/2025
