In space #115, there was no current activity plan posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/22/2026

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

The playgrounds do not have the required amount of protective surfacing (mulch) for the playground equipment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/1/2026

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

The gate leading to the younger playground is broken. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/1/2026

● **All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement.**

There was no documentation of an annual questionnaire for 1 staff member. Violation corrected during visit
