(1), and All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In the infant toddler classroom there were three (3) children's written feeding plan that was not signed. (I.C., F.O. and A.A) Violation confirmed corrected

- **Each Employee's Personnel File Did Not Contain an Annual Staff Evaluation and a Staff Development Plan.**

After review of the staff and training worksheet it was noted that five (5) staff members had not received their annual staff evaluation for 2024-2025. Violation confirmed corrected
