The shade trellis has rotted boards which are at a risk of falling off the trellis. One board has fallen and is suspended by vines only. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/28/2025

- **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The fire drill logged for March 2025 did not have the complete information required. The fire drill practiced 4/28/25 was not logged on the emergency drill log. Violation corrected during visit
