- **Meals/snacks Did Not Comply with the Meal Patterns for Children in Child Care Programs.**
The menu posted did not list the specific fruit served for each meal, but is listed as "fruit". Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/22/2026
- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**
Outdoors a cabinet was observed to be 7 and 1/4 inches away from the building causing an entrapment for children. A hard plastic playhouse located on the preschool playground had a broken and cracked door with sh
- **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. There was an outlet that did not have a safety
- **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**
Space 3, 4, 5, and 6 had plastic shopping bags and plastic packaging stored in unlocked changing table cabinets and accessible to children

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
