(1), Safe Pick-up and Delivery Procedures Were Not Communicated to Parents And/or Were Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen by the Parents. (1), and A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

There was no safe arrival and departure procedures posted. Violation corrected during visit

- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

In classroom KP, there was a packaging tape dispenser with a sharp edge used for cutting the tape. Violation corrected during visit
