(2), Openings in Equipment, Steps, Decks, Handrails, and Fencing Were Not Less Than 3 1/2 Inches or Greater Than 9 Inches. (1), and A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
