(1), and Application for Enrollment Did Not Include All Required Information. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

One (1) school aged child that is a 5-year-old was left alone in a classroom for approximately 8-10 minutes. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 7/16/2025

● **Potentially Hazardous Items Including but Not Limited to Power Tools, Nails, Chemicals, Propane Stoves, Lawn Mowers, Gasoline, or Kerosene Were Not Stored In...**

● **Application for Enrollment Did Not Include All Required Information.**

One child's application did not list the child's fears, unique behavior characteristics, allergies, and health concerns. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/24/2024
