(1), and Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Two staff covering from another KinderCare facility did not have a file on site for review. Violation corrected during visit

The bus used for transportation did not have a current registration. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/1/

● **Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,...**
