Jul 9, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

Twenty-three children were present today ages three to eight. The maximum group size for a three-year old child is twenty with a staff/child ratio of 1:10. This is a repeat violation. Violation confirmed corrected by letter r

- **Prior to Employment a Criminal Background Check Was Not Completed.**
