● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

On November 12, 2025, staff members failed to provide adequate supervision appropriate to the age, needs, and capabilities of a four-year-old child. During this time, the child ran from the classroom and through the courtyard and p

● **Prior to Employment a Criminal Background Check Was Not Completed.**

A substitute was used in the PreK class without a criminal background check. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/17/2025

● **A Valid Qualification Letter Was Not on File and Available to Review at the Facility.**

The substitute was used in a PreK class that did not have a qualifying letter on file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/17/2025

● **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

On October 21, 2025, a school employee handled a four-year-old child roughly when she grabbed the child by the arm. As a result, the child received significant ma

● **There Was a Substantiation of Child Maltreatment.**

Pursuant to its investigation, the Division has confirmed sufficient information to determine child maltreatment. Violation pending provider response
