Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance... (1), Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A... (1), and Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A...**
minimum of one month. During the walk through, an infant was observed awake in a crib. Documentation had not been completed on th
- **Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least...**
annually for each child. Emergency medical care information for five children had not been updated at least annually. Violatio
- **Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule.**
One child had two over-the-counter diaper ointments with expired authorization from the parent. Authorization expired September 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter
