Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were All Children Were Not Held or Placed in Feeding Chairs or Other Appropriate Apparatus to Be Fed. (1), Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), and A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

Space #3. two children exited the classroom without supervision. One child was found in the right-side bathroom with the door closed, and the teacher was unaware of the child's location for approximately thirty seconds. Violation c

● **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

Staff member S.B., grabbed a child's upper arms to prevent the child from harming other children in care. Marks were left on the child's arm due to the incident.
