On July 11, 2025 a two year old child was left unattended in the Two's classroom. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/11/2025

● **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

A teacher in the Two's classroom grabbed a child by their arm and forcefully swung the child away from the gate and on to the carpet in the classroom. Violation c

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. A staff member hired on 11/17/22 did not have a First

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. A staff member hired on 11/17/22 did not have a CP
