(1), and A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

On the playground there is a piece of equipment with broken plastic. There are also exposed footings. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/17/2026

● **A Drug or Medication Was Administered Without Written Authorization And/or Instructions From a Child's Parent or Authorized Health Professional.**

In one classroom there was a medication form for Aquaphor that was not signed by a parent or guardian. Violation confirmed corrected by lett

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date.**

In one classroom a tube of blistex was expired. This was corrected during the visit by the Director taking the medication out of the classroom. Violation corrected during visit

● **Leftover Medicines Were Not Returned to the Parent After the Course of Treatment Was Completed, After Authorization Was Withdrawn or After Authorization Had...**

expired and/or medication was not discarded within 72 hours of completion of treatment or withdrawal of authorization. In one cl
