Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (2), Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule. (1), and Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A small bottle of hand sanitizer with the labeled" keep out of reach of children" on the teacher's desk was accessible to children. Violation corrected during visit

● **Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule.**

The authorization to administer medication form completed by the parent for an EpiPen kept on site for one child enrolled expired on April 6, 2026. Violation confirmed correct

Jan 14, 2026 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection.**

Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The fire inspection report dated February 3,

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Boards were protruding from the decks on the front and back walkways posing a tripping hazard. Paint is peeling from the window seals on the four back entrance doors and exposing rust. Violation confirmed correct
