Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook. (1), Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access. (1), and Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space F there was an electric fan on the floor, uncovered and in reach of children. It was not in operation. Violation corrected during visit

- **Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule.**
In space F, two (2) children's medical permission authorization forms were out of date. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/5/2025
