Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (2), The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of. (1), and Potentially Hazardous Items Such as Archery Equipment, Hand and Power Tools, Nails, Chemicals, or Propane Stoves, Were Not Stored in Locked Areas or with Other... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Outdoors, black felt was exposed creating a tripping hazard at the base on the curved slide on the climber, at the base of the balance beam, around the purple metal climber, around the swings, and the purple bala

● **The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of.**

Outdoors, the premises were not checked once a day, prior to initial use, ensuring debris, and broken equipment was removed and disp

● **Potentially Hazardous Items Such as Archery Equipment, Hand and Power Tools, Nails, Chemicals, or Propane Stoves, Were Not Stored in Locked Areas or with Other...**
