Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible. (1), Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy. (1), and When Children 3 Years and Older Were in Care, Screen Time Was Not Used to Stimulate a Developmental Domain; Was Not Limited to 30 Minutes a Day and No More... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible.**

Cardboard blocks in space 12 had several with holes and in poor condition. Violation corrected during visit

- **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

In space 1, staff used sleep bags where the arms were sewed or stapled together to restrict movement to keep infants from waking up before time. Violation corrected during visit

- **When Children 3 Years and Older Were in Care, Screen Time Was Not Used to Stimulate a Developmental Domain; Was Not Limited to 30 Minutes a Day and No More...**

- **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook.**
