● 5 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met. (2), Lavatories Were Not Kept Clean, in Good Repair and Kept Free of Storage. (1), and Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Jun 2, 2026 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met.**
The group size ratio was not being maintained in space #4. Fourteen children ranging in age of three to five was being cared for with a maximum group size of twelve. Violation pending

May 19, 2026 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met.**
In space #2 seven two year olds and one (1) one-year old was observed being cared for by one staff member. Violation pending provider response

Mar 11, 2026 2 Findings ● 2 Important

- **Lavatories Were Not Kept Clean, in Good Repair and Kept Free of Storage.**
Car seats were observed stored in the bathroom upon arrival. Violation corrected during visit
Corrected at visit
- **Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A...**
minimum of one month. An infant child was observed not to have been visually checked and documented every 15 minutes in space #1.
