Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), and A Safe Indoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

A crib in the infant classroom was positioned in a location that obstructed the staff member being able to see that child. During the visit the teachers was at the diaper changing table and was unable to see the sleeping child. The

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

On the playground used for school-agers and pre-k children mulch did not measure nine inches in depth. The provider has roped off the area, and children are not permitted to play on he str

● **A Safe Indoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A metal support pipe for an umbrella, approximately eight inches in height, was observed on the two-year-old playground. A gate on the toddler playground that leads to the parking lot was observed without a lock. Violation c

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

A cabinet containing diaper creams was unlocked in the infant room. The assistant administrator added a lock to the cabinet during the visit. Violation correcte

● **A Child Care Operator Did Not Notify the Division of Any New Child Care Providers, as Defined in G.S. 110-90.2(a)(2), Who Were Hired or Moved Into the Child...**
