Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1), Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), and Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A plastic bag was stored on a hook in the hallway; accessible to children younger than three. Violation corrected during visit

● **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The last emergency drill was conducted on 3/13/25. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/29/2025

● **A Child's File Did Not Have a Statement with Parent Signature Acknowledging Receipt and Explanation of the Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head...**

Trauma policy and/or the acknowledgement did not have all the required information. Ten children files did not have a signed s
