(1), Products That Are Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Without Any Other Warnings, Were Not Stored on a Shelf or in an Unlocked Cabinet That Is Five Feet... (1), and Hazardous Cleaning Supplies and Other Items That Might Be Poisonous E.g. Toxic Plants, Were Not Out of Reach or in Locked Storage When Children Were in Care. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

An outdoor safety inspection was not completed in November. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/14/2025

In the outdoor learning environment, three holly bushes with berries were accessible to children. Violation confirmed corrected
