● 5 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Mar 4, 2026 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

On both playgrounds surfacing beside sidewalks has eroded away. On front playground surfacing around climbing structure has three holes. On front playground surfacing underneath fence by back door has washed away

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In space 9 and 12, outlets were left uncovered

Jul 9, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

There was chipped paint on the walls in indoor spaces #3, #5, #6, and #10. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/21/2025

May 21, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

On May 15, 2025, a staff member responded to an upset parent by yelling in front of the parents three-year-old child along with other children present on the play
