Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment. (1), and A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

There were plastic bags accessible to children in space #1, space #4, and space #5 which enrolls children under 3 years of age. Violation c

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

There were less than 2 inches of mulch around the climbing structure on the playground for children 2 to 5 years of age. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/7/2025

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date.**

A child's diaper cream in space #4 expired on 1/2023. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/18/2024
