(1), An Individual Written Feeding Plan Was Not Provided by Child's Parent or Health Care Provider or Was Not Followed and Posted. (Omit Posting for Centers Located... (1), and Each Child's Bed, Cot, or 2" Mat Was Not Individually Assigned and Identified. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Each Child's Diapers Were Not Changed at Areas Designated Exclusively for Diapering, on a Surface That Was Smooth, Nonabsorbent, Easily Cleanable and of Tight...**
construction. In space #3, there was a torn place in the vinyl of the changing pad. Violation pending provider response
- **An Individual Written Feeding Plan Was Not Provided by Child's Parent or Health Care Provider or Was Not Followed and Posted. (Omit Posting for Centers Located...**
in a residence) In space #1, one infant did not have a written feeding plan. Violation pending provider response
- **Each Child's Bed, Cot, or 2" Mat Was Not Individually Assigned and Identified.**
In space #9, the cots were labeled with numbers however their wasn't a chart showing the cots were individually assigned. Violation pending provider response
- **Diaper Changing Surfaces Were Not Kept Free of Storage.**
In space #8, a child's pair of tennis shoes were stored on the changing pad. Violation corrected during visit

- **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**
Throughout the building peeling paint was observed on the chair rail molding, windowsills and around exit doors. Violation pending provider response
