(1), Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (1), and Prohibited Styrofoam and Foam Rubber Products Were Accessible to Children Under 3 Years of Age And/or Approved Foam Products Were Used Without Proper... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
