Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1), For Children Under Three Years of Age, Developmentally Appropriate Toys and Activities Were Not Provided as Outlined in Rule. (1), and Any Excess Formula, Thawed Human Milk And/or Bottled Beverage Were Not Discarded or Returned Home at the End of Each Day. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

Paint on the handicap ramp in the front of the center was wearing off and splintering. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/3/2025

Feb 25, 2025 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **For Children Under Three Years of Age, Developmentally Appropriate Toys and Activities Were Not Provided as Outlined in Rule.**

The classroom for one and two year old children did not have any dolls or blocks. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/10/2025

● **Any Excess Formula, Thawed Human Milk And/or Bottled Beverage Were Not Discarded or Returned Home at the End of Each Day.**

A bottle of milk and a sippy cup of milk were sitting on a shelf after being fed. They were emptied during the visit. Violation corrected during visit

Corrected at visit

● **Openings in Equipment, Steps, Decks, Handrails, and Fencing Were Not Less Than 3 1/2 Inches or Greater Than 9 Inches.**

The railings on the ramp leading from the preschool building to the infant toddler building were more than 3 1/2 inches but less than nine inches. Violation confirmed
