The teacher assistant's staff file in the NC Pre-K classroom was not available for review today. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/21/2023

● **The Center Did Not Complete an EPR Plan Within Four Months of Completing the EPR in Child Care Training And/or the Plan Was Not Completed on a Template...**
