On the playground for preschool children, the caterpillar tunnel had two cracks approximately two inches long on the plastic "tail" end of the caterpillar, accessible to children. Violation confirmed corrected by I

In the fall zone areas on the sides and exit of the tall pink slide, only four to five inches of mulch was observed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/12/
