Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were An Individual Written Feeding Plan Was Not Provided by Child's Parent or Health Care Provider or Was Not Followed and Posted. (1), Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), and Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
